This research contributed toward the management and conservation of South African marine ecosystems and setting conservation targets for these ecosystems.

Beyond research, she is dedicated to empowering youth and fostering environmental

stewardship. As a marine mentor and Director of the #SeaTheBiggerPicture Ocean Initiative NPO, she co-leads their "Defenders of the Blue" Citizen Science Programme, working to build ocean awareness and water confidence among young people in surrounding local communities.
