### Climate change and the Endangered African penguin:

### SANCCOB's involvement in important management interventions

Dr Katta Ludynia has been working with southern African seabirds for more than 16 years and conducted her PhD on African penguins and Cape gannets in Namibia. She was a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the University of Cape Town (UCT) and has been with SANCCOB as the Research Manager since 2017. Katta is involved in many different research projects both at SANCCOB and with birds in the wild, and coordinates the long-term marking of African penguins using inserted transponders to understand their movement and long-term survival. Katta is currently collaborating with the SANParks CRC team on a study looking at climate change effects on African penguins breeding at Boulders.
