Applications are invited for the position of ORI Tagging Officer (Assistant Scientist)

The Oceanographic Research Institute (ORI), a division of the South African Association for Marine Biological Research (SAAMBR) requires a suitably qualified person to undertake the role of managing the ORI's Collaborative Fish Tagging Project. The position is a fixed term contract, dependent on the annual availability of project funds.

The responsibilities will include:

- Regular liaison with scientists, tagging members, anglers and the public;
- overseeing data capture and database management;
- facilitating website and social media management;
- managing technical staff associated with the project;
- managing project expenditure within budgeted amounts;
- analysing data and disseminating research findings in both the popular and scientific literature;
- · assisting other scientists within the organisation.

The following will be required of the successful applicant:

- Minimum of an MSc degree in marine science or other relevant field;
- excellent writing and communication skills;
- computer literacy with experience in database management and data analysis;
- some angling experience and a good knowledge of South Africa's linefish species; and
- physically fit and capable of strenuous work in the field.
