- consumer behaviour and its role in plastic pollution
- extended producer responsibility (EPR)

The experts will work with the SST Education Team in Port Elizabeth or can work remotely. The successful applicants must:

- have an appropriate tertiary qualification (ideally Master's degree or higher qualifications)
- have excellent writing skills
- understand the issues related to plastic pollution
- be sensitive to cultural requirements in Africa so that the education resource book can be adapted to different groups on the continent and its island states
