A vacancy exists for the position of an Environmental Resource Economist to improve the financial sustainability of Protected Areas (PA) Network and manage Component 3 of the project. The position will be stationed at the SANParks Conservation Services: Park Planning & Development offices in Port Elisabeth.

Purpose of the Job:

To improve the financial sustainability of Protected Areas (PA) Network through reducing costs of expansion, improving cost efficiencies within PA management agencies, including resilience of existing income streams and manage Component 3 of the project.

Key tasks and responsibilities:

- To develop a social and economic optimal framework for protected area expansion in partnership with communities and private landowners.
- To implement Component 3 of the UNDP GEF Improving management effectiveness of the Protected Ares Network.
- To support the development of detailed financial scenarios for various conservation land use options for both community and private partnerships.
- To develop an implementation plan for identified financially sustainable partnerships for the new protected areas and the buffer zones.
- To optimize income streams and revenue derived and improve cost efficiencies, by developing and implementing protected area financing models.
- To develop models for the establishment of an offset receiving trust fund to hold and disburse ringfenced reserve expansion and management funds and piloting of offset receiving area.
- To develop and implement commercialization strategies for co-managed areas, and potential investments in ecological infrastructure.
 - To produce synthesis reports documenting the results and highlighting way-forward, as well as lessons learnt with respect to low-cost protected areas expansion and the socio-economic development within which the protected area is located.
