

The **South African Environmental Observation Network (SAEON)** is a research platform funded by the Department of Science and Innovation (DSI) and managed by the National Research Foundation (NRF). SAEON is mandated to establish and manage long-term environmental observatories; maintain reliable long-term environmental data sets; promote access to data for research and/or informed decision making; and contribute to capacity building. ## Key responsibilities will include:

- Day-to-day responsibility for administration and operational management of the Shallow Marine and Coastal Research Infrastructure
- Provide leadership to a range of services that support sound management and the sustainable development of SMCRI, underpinned by good governance practices.
- Coordinate business improvement and benchmarking projects for SMCRI, including contract management, audit processes and improved compliance.
- Draft relevant documentation in support of the portfolio, including promotional content management, progress reports (monthly, quarterly and annual) and annual performance plans
- Coordinate management agreements (MoUs, SLAs, lease agreements, etc.) and permits required by the Node to meet organizational objectives.
- Coordinate Supply Chain Management activities at SMCRI to meet business objectives and compliance

## **Requirements:**

- Minimum education required: MSc, MCom and/or diploma in Project Management
- 3+ years relevant experience in a research project management environment Evidence of exceptional performance in professional project management and / or supporting research-related project delivery under minimum supervision.
- Demonstrable passion for marine and coastal ecosystems
- Highly developed interpersonal skills, including the ability to develop collaborative partnerships with both internal and external stakeholders
- Proven effective leadership skills that drive team work, high performance and excellence in service provision.
- Evidence of ability to synthesize complex material underpinned by high level written communication skills, to support the development of business/performance plans, progress report submissions, agreements, permit applications and public relations material.
- Strategic thinker with highly-developed problem solving skills.
- Proven understanding of South African Supply Chain Management (SCM) policy and guidelines
- Proven ability to work as part of a diverse team
- Record of establishing and maintaining a framework for continuous improvement.
- A valid code B driver's license.
